

SERIES UPDATE AS OF 04/06/2018



Series is the 2018 USA Cycling Mountain Bike XC State Championship as a “series” for California. A USA Cycling MTB XC State Championship Series includes two or more events in which riders accumulate points in discipline/class/category/age toward an overall cumulative points total for the series of 5 races. The highest ranking rider of each discipline/class/category determines the USA Cycling State Championship winner/title.

In the event of a points tie, it will be determined by the finish order at the most recent event (Race 5). The top three licensed riders in the point series will be awarded state champion medals and a CA state champion jersey. You must have a current annual license BEFORE starting Race 5 to be eligible for the state championships. The racer’s age on December 31 of the current year is used to determine which age class the racer competes in. No age group changes should need to occur during the series. If a rider upgrades or downgrades their category during the series, they will not carry any points with them between categories.

2018 USA Cycling annual racing license required. Annual licenses (\$75) are available at www.usacycling.org.

\$10 One-Day licenses are for categories only (Cat 2-Interm. and Cat 3-Beginners).

\$25 One-Day licenses are for categories (Cat 1-Expert).

Those racing on one-day licenses will not be eligible for the state/regional championship or qualify for nationals. Collegiate licenses can upgrade to an annual USAC license for \$10 on race day to be a current annual license holder.

Special Instructions at Sea Otter MTB XC on-line Registration:

For entry to CA Dirt MTB Race Series, you must select the appropriate category. You must select the category to be used for CA Dirt MTB Series. We will manually apply your race results to our series category to be compliant to USAC MTB XC state championship categories and age group.

USACycling's ANTI-DOPING PROGRAM

As a USAC sanctioned event hosting state championships, any of our race events may be selected at random for USAC Anti-Doping Program protocol. What does this mean? At random, our race announcer may call your name or plate number to report to registration booth, or a volunteer may ask and/or escort you to the registration booth. Please follow instructions to efficiently go through the process and so your race day may continue. Racer is not allowed to race if he or she declines anti-doping program testing.

\$10 – PARKING

Parking fee covers our volunteer lunches, signage, and miscellaneous venue expenses. Please have cash ready as our parking volunteers direct to parking spaces. Please park in event parking as some of our races are in residential areas, or in public recreational areas for general public parking. Funds go towards event permits, port-a-potty rentals, and volunteer t-shirts and lunches.
