REQUIREMENTS

Read Important Steps Below To Save You Grief and Time Before You Register Online at BikeReg

- Log into your USAC license profile or open the USAC mobile app to display and update your XC category status for this race season as one of the following:
 RD: 05, CX: 05, XC: 03, TR: 05, DH: 03, MX: 03
- Why your race cat/age group entry must match your USA race license status category for XC. Racers, BEFORE registering for any of series races online at BikeReg, update your USAC racer profile XC category (upgrade or downgrade). Why? This step assures you are registered for a race category/age group per your race license status for this race season. BikeReg emails us immediately if there is a difference, you perform an override during online registration, and someone from our staff will call you. Again, register for a race as stated on your race license, so your racer data is correct before we download BikeReg racer data for timing services and race plate assignments.



- If everything matches on race day check-in volunteers will hand you your assigned race plate no. so you can warm up before your start time.
- You can avoid race day holding up the check-in line on RACE Day if you update your USAC profile XC category and state residence BEFORE you register on-line.
- For USAC Regional MTB XC Championship Series points (USAC winners strip insignia on championship jersey), racers are required to:
 - be a current year USAC annual license holder,
 - USAC racer profile shows racer as a resident of California or Nevada by week of Race 4,
 - Complete on-line registration and digital waiver at BikeReg registration.
- For California Dirt MTB Series points (championship jersey), same as the above, (for any US residents).
- For Pro/Cat 1 racers:
 - If you have an EXPIRED USAC annual license, a \$35 One-Day (Experienced) License is required (allowed one time a year), and may be purchased <u>online only</u>, NOT AVAILABLE at race venue on Race Day <u>or</u> during BikeReg race registration Explanation of USA Cycling race fees for "Experienced ONE Day License", <u>here</u>.
 - To receive purse funds, your USAC race license must show the following status as XC:PRO (not CAT 1) and complete an IRS W-9 form.

- For racers who just want to race and are not interested in earning series points
 - a USAC One Day License (\$15) is required, and available when registering on-line at BikeReg. If a racer is interested in this series points, any One Day License fee is applied toward online purchasing an annual license at <u>USACycling</u>.
 Please do this 2 weeks before the last date as we will re-run cumulative points before Race 4.

- We need a couple of days to confirm racer registration data before downloading racer registration data for timing services, contact racers (who missed clicking on the "I Agree" box for the digital waiver), and reduce check-in line on race day. This makes the race day check-in line move fast!

You EARNED a FREE USA Cycling Jr. license/membership by completing this <u>form</u> (click "form" to open form) to receive a unique, one-time code associated with your respective NICA League. And You get to apply for a FREE USAC junior race license. NEXT, go to USA Cycling, <u>usacycling.org</u> to sign up, using the code delivered to your email after completing NorCal's online form in above link. Please do this 1 week before the last date as we will re-run cumulative points before Race 4.

- <u>YBONC Members and Student Athletes</u>, as YBONC members, benefit from the new \$25 off code when you sign-up for any USAC membership/race license. Your YBONC affiliated club advisor will share this code with YBONC members. Enter the code when you check-out purchasing your USA Cycling License:
 For +19 y.o., click here.
- Junior racers who DO NOT race with the NICA/NorCal MTB HS Racing League or not riding with a YBONC <u>affiliated bike club</u>, to apply for a USA Cycling junior race license/membership, click <u>here</u>.
- You do not need a race license If you are racing in the age 5 y.o. or under category in this series. A parent or legal guardian may mentor/escort your child during the race after an adult has signed an event volunteer waiver for racer. A junior racer age 5-7 y.o. must have a completed event waiver and complete one lap by 1HH:30MM.
 Yes, we've had determined young shredders complete a 3-4 mile course in the past, or the under 1 mile ST course.
- <u>Problems with your USAC license</u>, PLEASE update your racer profile <u>BEFORE registering for races in this</u> <u>series</u>. Upgrades or downgrades can be performed with:

- If you procrastinate and register close to the race date, you may not get your t-shirt size. We order t-shirt counts by 0 size 3 weeks before race dates.
- Defining Your Race Age when registering Age on 12/31/23 is your race age per USAC rulebook:
 - 0 Your race age is 17 y.o. if you are 17 y.o. on 12/31/23.
 - Your race age is 18 y.o. if you are 18 y.o. on 12/31/23. 0
- PLEASE ... CLICK the "I Agree" button for digital waiver when registering for a race at BikeReg. We have gone paperless; racer waivers are digital for us to download and print for race day check-in. This makes race day check-in line move fast! We will call you to log into BikeReg and click the "I AGREE" button if your racer name shows on BikeReg's pending racer waiver report.
- If you are a 1st PLACE contender in your category/age group, please complete the championship jersey size so we can place championship jersey order after Race 3 is completed. Enter your jersey size AND your shipping address information during BikeReg registration, in case you are not racing in Race 4 and we will mail you your Regional championship jersey and applicable medal.
- One day race discipline 1st Place winners for Enduro and eBike races, jersey will be mailed to you after jersey order is placed after Race 4.

- A race series is defined as <u>two or more events</u>. CA Dirt MTB Series and USA Cycling MTB Regional Championship Series is about riders accumulating points in discipline/class/category/age toward overall cumulative points for the series of 4 races, except for the following single day disciplines: Enduro and eBike.
- USA Cycling racer profile points start a new accrual round after 2023 MTB National Championships end.

This means Race 1 through Race 3 count towards 2023 USA Cycling MTB Nationals. Race 4 counts towards 2024 USA Cycling MTB Nationals.

- Participating racers must be a 2023 USAC license holder <u>BEFORE starting Race 4</u> to be eligible for the USAC Regional MTB or CA Dirt MTB championships. Any 1 Day Race License fee is applied to purchase a 2023 USAC annual license online at USA Cycling. If you do this, PLEASE purchase a license 2 weeks before Race 4 if you are a contender for 1st Place in a series for overall points.
- ALL racers who finish in the top-15 of their entry category and age group at the end of Race 4 qualify for 2023 USA Cycling's MTB National Championships, July 5-9, 2023, Bear Creek Mountain Resort, Lehigh Valley, Pennsylvania, details <u>here</u>.
- <u>To update USAC points for an USA Cycling annual license holder's account to reflect race results</u> <u>achieved with a one-day license</u>, please contact USA Cycling Membership Services department at <u>membership@usacycling.org</u> or 719-434-4200. We do not have access to USA Cycling's points system.

Be Ready for Race Day at Venues

• **REQUIRED** ...

Proof your 2023 USAC race license showing your cat/age group when you check-in for our races.

 Check-in volunteers confirm to match your race entry with your USAC race license for XC category and age: Pro (or UCI) Cat 1 Cat 2 Cat 3.

Why? Cell phone service is poor at our race venues and there's a good chance you will not be able to do an online USAC race license edit with your cell phone to perform a category upgrade or downgrade...copy or screen capture works.

- No RACE Day Walk-Up Registration
 - Why? All race event waivers are digital, processed online at BikeReg registration. We print racer waivers for check-in volunteers and attach race results with post event paperwork.
- Keep our event safe. Please stay home if you have any cold-like symptoms.
- Attach your race plate to your bars with cables on the backside and it is facing forward for course marshals to read and report your race plate number by radio for any reason as you are racing by them. (If you can read your race plate number when sitting on the saddle, re-attach your race plate on the bars again so it's facing forward like car headlights.)



- Know your start time and arrive 10 minutes early for pre-race announcements.
- Racers must start/finish on the same bike, no exchange of parts or aid from others unless you carry it yourself, per USAC rules.
- If you're racing a 2 day weekend race, you keep the same race plate for both days.
- No littering PLEASE. Place any sport food wrappers in your pockets or shorts leg. Bring a trash bag for your personal trash or recyclable items and please take your trash home. Pack-It-In Pack-It-Out Policy!
- Check Lost & Found Box at the next race if you lost any item(s) at previous race.
- If you are spectating, camping, PLEASE leave no trace, pack it in/pack it out.
- Our events follow state and local CoVID guidelines based on each race location by county. With new viruses each year, and people not fully vaccinated, please social distance or mask up in public and at check-in until USAC blows his start whistle to prevent spreading of illness to our staff of volunteers and racers.
